



PACKING LIST CAMP WEBB

WHAT TO BRING AND WHAT NOT TO BRING

PLEASE MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.
CAMP WEBB IS NOT LIABLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.

Bedding:

- Sleeping bag or bed roll (sheets and three blankets)
- Pillow

Note: a lightweight sleeping bag may need an extra blanket

Clothing for 6 days:

- Shirts
- Heavy sweater or jacket
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Shorts
- Jeans or long pants
- Underwear
- Socks
- Hooded sweatshirt of fleece for cool nights
- Swim suit (***Please note: Two piece swimsuits and/or boys speedo type swimming suits are not permitted at Camp Webb.***)
- Pajamas
- Sandals and/or flip flops for beach and showering
- Two pairs of close toed shoes
- Beach Towel

Medications:

Do not pack any medications in your child's luggage. ACA standards prohibit medications of any kind in cabins. Bring all medicines (including all non-prescription items like aspirin, vitamins, allergy medication, etc.) in their original containers and in a Ziploc bag with the child's name on it to the camp medic/nurse on opening day.

DO NOT BRING:

- Food
- Candy
- Gum
- Radio/cd/mp3 players

Toiletries:

- Shampoo
- Towels and wash cloth
- Comb or brush
- Soap
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher)
- Insect Repellent (a must have)
- Deodorant
- Chapstick
- Lotion
- Bath Towel/beach towel

Miscellaneous:

- Water bottle with name on it
- Two plastic bags with ties for wet or highly soiled clothing
- Inexpensive camera and film (disposable cameras work great!)
- Small Flashlight with extra batteries
- Pre-addressed, stamped envelopes for writing home or to friends and family
- Bible

- Handheld games
- Cell phones
- Knives
- Sharp instruments
- Money and/or Valuables

All "do not bring" items will be collected upon arrival and put in a marked bag. If discovered during camp, the staff will bring them to the Camp Director. The items will be securely stored in the office, and will be returned at the close of camp. To protect the well-being of everyone at camp, luggage may be subject to search upon arrival.
