The Gift of Education



Because of the Diocese of Milwaukee's long term commitment to St Marc's School in rural Haiti, thousands of children have had access to a quality education.

- Many walk from surrounding communities, some as long as an hour, to attend St. Marc's School due to its reputation and results.
- The school has grown from ~150 children in 1986 to ~525 in 2015.
- There are 178 students in High school - many if not most of these students would *never* be able to complete high school without St. Marc's School.
- The Project employs all the teachers and administrators, several are former St. Marc's School students.
- Schooling children locally is safer and benefits families, the community, and the country through decentralization from Port Au Prince - a dangerously overcrowded city.
- Many young parents are now able to read to their children
