### Diocese of Milwaukee Executive Council Minutes June 7, 2022 6:30 p.m. via ZOOM

At 6:31 p.m. Bishop Jeff Lee called the meeting to order and led the EC in prayer.

#### May 3, 2022 EC Minutes

Deacon Marge Kiss asked if there were any additions, deletions or changes to the Executive Council minutes of the May 3, 2022 EC meeting. The minutes were amended, correcting Under Special Moments for EC members, Rev. Steve Capitelli's Mr. John Vogel's son getting married (the same day as the Celebration of New Ministry for Father Fleischman)

#### **Request RE: Hospitality Center Bylaws**

The Rev. Seth Raymond gave a brief background and rationale for changes to the Hospitality Center bylaws requested by the HC board:

--That Article I.E. be changed to require a minimum of six directors.

--That Article III.B. be added to the bylaws: <u>Affiliation with the Evangelical Lutheran</u> <u>Church in America (ELCA)</u> and

--That Article III.D.5. be added to the bylaws: At least three members of the Board of Directors shall be active members of ELCA congregations within the Greater Milwaukee Synod. In the case one or more of these seats are vacated, they will be filled within three months. The board will retain authority to act while these seats are filled.

Questions regarding the history and current life of the Hospitality Center were addressed. **\*\*\***Mr. John Vogel moved that the above presented changes to the bylaws of the Hospitality Center be approved. Dr. John Johnson seconded the motion. The motion

carried.

#### **Updates on Trialogue**

The Rev. Jana Troutman-Miller focused on:

--the role of the steering committee

--the only current question -- reunification

#### Update from the Canon for Ministries

Bishop Lee stated that, although the Canon for Ministries was not at the meeting, his report was in drop box. Bishop Lee especially noted and strongly recommended the council read the other paper Father Scott Leannah submitted to drop box: Assisting parishes: re-development status and Canon 8

#### Finances

Ms. Caroline Senn, the Financial Controller, gave a detailed report regarding the work of the finance office and why certain areas of finance were not available for review at this meeting, primarily, lack of accuracy.

Her goals:

--by June, a balance sheet with accurate information

--by the end of the year, a clean Chart of Accounts

#### Haiti Update

**D**r. John Johnson, as point person of the Haiti Project Committee, introduced the other current members: the Rev. Roger Mukasa and the Rev. Steve Capitelli.

He then noted that the committee is in the process of discerning the pathway forward. He requested that the EC approve funding for the school for the next 12 months as a "cushion" during the time of discernment.

**\*\*\***The Rev. Steve Capitelli moved that The Executive Council resolve that the EDOM continue to fund the FOUNDATION partnership with Jeanette Haiti for the 2022 / 2023 school year while the best way forward for EDOM was determined. Mr. Michael Weber seconded the motion.

Detailed discussion followed.

The motion carried.

#### **Final Thoughts**

Bishop Lee asked for prayers for:

--The Rt. Rev. Edwin Leidel, Jr. who died June 5<sup>th</sup> (Pentecost Sunday). His funeral is June 18<sup>th</sup> at Christ Church Episcopal Church, Whitefish Bay.

--The clergy traveling to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area on the Canadian border in northern Minnesota.

Bishop Lee gave the closing prayer and blessing. Deacon Marge said the dismissal.
